### HISTORICAL NOTE

In the mid to late 19th century, New Bedford Massachusetts was the center of the global whaling industry. At its zenith in 1857, ships from New Bedford and surrounding towns represented half of all the world's whaling catch. The industry supported both the whale fishing industry as well as a vast shore economy that resulted in massive wealth. In subsequent decades, the industry suffered a gradual decline as overfishing and technological changes resulted in less demand for whale products. This collection includes photographic images that document the latter period of the New Bedford whaling industry.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE COLLECTION

The collection includes glass plate negatives and photographic prints of various whaling ships as well as streets, wharves and other buildings in New Bedford, Massachusetts in the late 19th and early 20th centuries.

### **ORGANIZATION OF THE COLLECTION**

The collection is organized by format and size. Included are glass and film negatives of various sizes, but the bulk are 5x7 and 8x10. Prints are housed together and are organized to correspond with associated negatives. Prints for which PPL does own the original negatives are organized at the end.
