#### HISTORICAL NOTE

Dr. Virginia Thomas is a scholar of American Studies who completed her PhD at Brown University in 2020 with a focus on race, gender and sexuality in U.S. culture and history. She was awarded an Equity Action Grant by the Rhode Island Foundation in 2020 to complete a series of oral history recordings with members of Rhode Island's LGBTQ+ community.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE COLLECTION
